Mini Cooper Grand Prix

Number 6 of 35 Special Edition individually numbered cars.

This car is one of only 35 cars launched by the man himself, John Cooper, to celebrate 35 years of the Mini & Cooper Racing Cars winning F1 Grand Prix World Championships. A number of the other 34 cars are owned by world famous celebrities such as Nigel Mansell and Nikki Lauda. A few even reside in Japan and Australia and to our knowledge there are about 12 in the UK.



Registered from new in 1994 to John Cooper's own personal name and address, my wife Sandie purchased GP No. 6 with 880 miles on the clock from John Cooper Garages in 1995. Current mileage is only 39,500 miles and it is taxed to the end of August 2005 & MOT'd to January 2006.

The Grand Prix cars are fitted with a host of incredible modifications including; an 86 Bhp engine conversion using the respected Weber Alpha fuel injection, full Koni Sport adjustable suspension, special soft Connolly hide beige leather interior, masses of burr walnut, magnolia dials, extra gauges, Cooper alloy fittings and unique exterior decals and badging.

This car takes the Grand Prix experience further in that it is the only car to have been professionally converted to a full Zeemax CS body conversion by the company in November 1998. It is the perfect choice for a fantastic car with such a high pedigree.

Also chosen were MB Racing 7 x 13 split rim alloys shod with Pirelli P7F tyres, a complete Jaguar pile carpet conversion, a full set of Hi-Lo' suspension, a full stainless steel Play-Mini exhaust emerging with twin upswept tailpipes, unique Cooper Car Company colours and the fitment of original chrome Lucas LR6 and FT9 Spot and Fog lights which are a rarity in such excellent condition.



This car is featured as the Mini Magazine August 1999 Cover Car. In standard form it retailed for £13,495 in 1994. A further £6,000 has been lovingly invested in it's conversion to produce such a unique vehicle.

It is pristine in all respects and has been exceptionally maintained and cherished. All receipts and history have been kept with the car which can be viewed today on the [Six Ex Mini Owners Club stand](#) (look for the yellow flag). **Selling for £10,250 ovno.**
